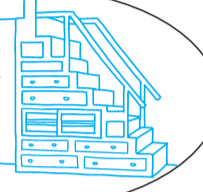

So many antique cameras collected by the former store owner.



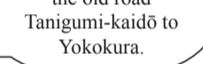
Drawer under a staircase is amazing.
